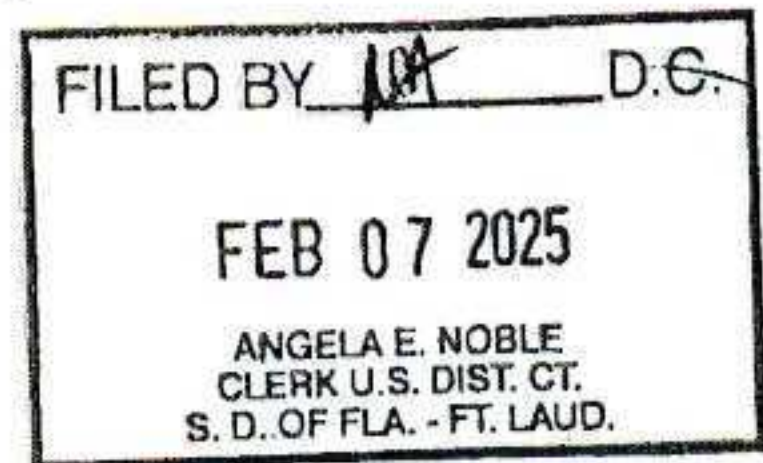

**GROUND ONE:** VIOLATION OF FOURTH AMENDMENT.

A CBP SUPERVISING OFFICER ARRESTED ME WITHOUT ISSUING A WARRANT.

On November 13, 2024 I along with my husband and his brother-in-law arrived at Cruz Bay, VI on a private boat.

Upon our arrival, we went into a CBP station, which was adjacent to the private boat pier, for inspection.

At the CBP station, we encountered Officer Zammot, who checked our documents and statuses, then questioned the circumstances of our arrival. Upon his inspection, Officer Zammot released us on our own recognizance.

Three days later, his supervisor invited us into his CBP station at Blyden Ferry Terminal, where he detained us.

At the end of day, he arrested me and the brother-in-law for being illegal in the country without issuing a warrant.

## GROUND TWO: VIOLATION OF FIRST AMENDMENT.

THE SUPERVISORY CBP OFFICER RETALIATED AGAINST ME, BECAUSE MY HUSBAND CHALLENGED HIS AUTHORITY TO DEPORT ME AND HIS BROTHER-IN-LAW;

(a) Supporting facts *(Be brief. Do not cite cases or law.)*:

When we went into the CBP station at Blyden Port Terminal, its supervisor started questioning our immigration statuses. My husband explained him that we were asylum seekers, who had already passed the CBP inspection and were admitted into the country by Officer Zammot. The CBP supervisor declined to discuss the circumstances of our arrival and focused on our entry documents only. Once he learned that we did not have any entry document except for passports, he concluded that we were illegal in the country and warned my husband not to debate that matter anymore or else he said that I and the brother-in-law would face a hard consequence in the form of our deportation. My husband challenged his authority to deport us and was immediately ordered to leave the building.
