

you are in federal or state custody because of something other than a judgment of conviction (for example, you are in pretrial detention or are awaiting extradition); or

- you are alleging that you are illegally detained in immigration custody.
- Who Should Not Use This Form. You should not use this form if 2.
 - you are challenging the validity of a federal judgment of conviction and sentence (these challenges are
