 - 9. ICE has a valid travel document for Petitioner.
- Petitioner was previously scheduled for removal to Russia, but due to flight delays,
 Petitioner missed his connecting flight and was forced to return to BTC. Petitioner is rescheduled
 to be removed from the United States to Russia within the next 30 days. ICE routinely removes
 noncitizens via commercial flights to Russia, subject to availability. Inasmuch as there is no issue
 regarding Petitioner's nationality. I believe there is a significant likelihood of Petitioner's removal
 in the reasonably foreseeable future.

DECLARATION OF DEPORTATION OFFICER JOHN MANSEY


I, John Mansey, hereby declare:

- 1. I am a Deportation Officer for Enforcement and Removal Operations (ERO), Immigration and Customs Enforcement (ICE), U.S. Department of Homeland Security, (DHS). I am assigned to Detained Case Management at the Broward Transitional Center (BTC) located in Pompano Beach, Florida. I have been employed by ICE since December 20, 2009.
- 2. Aliens who are in exclusion, deportation, or removal proceedings under the Immigration and Nationality Act are detained at Service Processing Centers or other detention locations under the authority of ICE, as are those who are pending appeal results from the Board of Immigration Appeals (BIA), or those with administrative final orders of removal who are being processed for removal to their native countries.
- 3. Alexey Samokhin (Petitioner) is currently detained at the BTC located in Pompano Beach, Florida. I am familiar with his case based on my review of his administrative file and the

information detailed in ICE's electronic databases. The purpose of this declaration is to provide information to the Court regarding Petitioner's removal status.

- 4. Petitioner is a native and citizen of Russia. Petitioner was admitted to the United States at Miami, Florida on or about April 14, 2022, as a B2 visitor for pleasure, with authorized stay in the United States until October 13, 2022.
- 5. On June 9, 2024, Petitioner was arrested in Naples, Collier County, Florida for Driving Under the Influence of Alcohol in violation of Florida Statutes § 316.193. The case is pending before the County Court for the Twentieth Judicial Circuit, in and for Collier County, Florida.
- 6. On June 10, 2024, Petitioner was taken into ICE custody, pursuant to Warrant of Arrest. On June 11, 2024, Petitioner was placed into removal proceedings upon service and filing of a Notice to Appear (NTA). The NTA charged Petitioner with removability pursuant to § 237(a)(1)(B) of the Immigration and Nationality of Act, as amended, in that after admission as a nonimmigrant under §101(a)(15) of the Act, Petitioner remained in the United States for a time longer than permitted, in violation of the Act or any other law of the United States.
- 7. On November 1, 2024, the immigration judge denied the Petitioner's application for relief and ordered Petitioner removed to Russia. The court's order reserved Petitioner's right to appeal the order of removal to the Board of Immigration Appeals (BIA), the administrative appellate body having jurisdiction to review the decision. On November 14, 2024, Petitioner, through counsel, filed a motion with the immigration court, requesting the issuance of a final removal order, indicating Petitioner would not be appealing the immigration judge's removal order. On November 14, 2024, the immigration judge re-issued the November 1, 2024, removal order indicating that Petitioner waived appeal.
