GROUNDS FOR RELIEF

- A. My detention by respondent ICE is in violation of my rights to procedural and substantive due process, as guaranteed by the Fifth Amendment to the United States Constitution.
- B. Because I am seeking relief related only to my custody status, which is not inconsistent with an order of deportation, exhaustion of administrative remedies, if any, is not required.
- C. Because there is not good reason to believe my removal will be effectuated in the reasonably foreseeable future, ICE has no statutory authority pursuant to 8 U.S.C. § 1231(a)(6) to detain me. Zadvydas v. Davis, 533 U.S. 678 (2001); Lin Guo Xi v. INS, 298 F.3d 832 (9th Cir. 2002); Thai v. Ashcroft, 366 F.3d 790 (9th Cir. 2004).
- D. I was taken into ICE custody on March 12, 2024. My order of removal became final on August 20, 2024. As of today's date, ICE has not been able to effectuate my removal because my country, Somalia, will not accept my return. I have done everything that ICE has asked me to do to try to get travel documents and will
