

18 Petitioner Anwar Mohamed Jeylani hereby requests that the Court appoint the
19 office of the Federal Public Defender for the Western District of Washington, or such
20 other counsel as the Court may deem appropriate, to represent him in this matter.

22 Petitioner does not have the financial resources to retain counsel as he is presently in
23 custody. For these reasons, and because the present petition presents novel and complex
24 issues of law, appointment of counsel would serve the interests of justice. Many other
25 ICE detainees are or will be raising similar habeas challenges against respondents, and

1 this Court will benefit from the contributions of experienced, federal counsel in
2 examining these claims. In addition, if an evidentiary hearing is necessary in this case,
3 Petitioner will need the assistance of counsel for such a hearing.
