TO SHOW CAUSE

Nestor Alonzo Hernandez-Gonzalez respectfully offers the following response to
the Court's Order to Show Cause issued February 28, 2025. Dkt. 5.

Mr. Hernandez-Gonzalez offers a motion for leave to proceed in forma pauperis,
along with his declaration that he has only \$14 money on his commissary account (*see*
Exhibit A). Mr. Hernandez's-Gonzalez's commissary balance has been certified by the
Northwest ICE Processing Center. Unfortunately, Mr. Hernandez-Gonzalez mailed the
only copy of that certification to counsel and it had not arrived by the deadline to file
this response to the Court's OSC. Counsel will supplement the record when we receive
that letter, likely this coming Monday.

1 Mr. Hernandez-Gonzalez has no income and virtually no funds. He therefore
