PETITION FOR AN EMERGENCY WRIT OF HABEAS CORPUS UNDER 28 U.S.C. § 2241

Decision or Action You Are Challenging

4. On September 19, 2021 Mr. Ramos was served a Notice to Appear from The Department of Homeland Security. See Exhibit 1.
5. On March 24, 2025 while attending his ICE check in at the Philadelphia ICE location he was detained by ICE and sent to the Federal Detention Center.
6. There is no record of The Notice To Appear being filed with the EOIR Court.
7. There is no Immigration Court with Jurisdiction over Petitioner.

GROUND ONE: Pursuant to Chapter 9.3 Bond Proceedings an Immigration Judge generally has jurisdiction to conduct a bond hearing if the alien is in Department of Homeland Security (DHS) custody.

The Immigration Judge also has Jurisdiction to conduct a bond hearing even if a charging document has not been filed. In addition, and immigration Judge has jurisdiction to rule on whether he or she has jurisdiction to conduct a bond hearing.

Respondent is not the following:

an alien in exclusion proceedings.

An arriving alien in removal proceedings.

Ineligible for release on security related grounds.

GROUND TWO: Petitioner has an asylum application filed on his behalf with his Wife and two children.

Petitioner has been working lawfully with a social security card and work authorization.

It is unnecessary to detain Petitioner at the government cost away from his family that he supports, as he waits for an asylum interview.

WHEREFORE: PETITIONER respectfully requests a bond hearing scheduled for him in Philadelphia County PA immediately.
