**PLAINTIFF'S MOTION FOR TEMPORARY RESTRAINING  
ORDER**

Plaintiff Parth Atul Chatwani hereby moves for a Temporary Restraining Order (TRO) seeking to enjoin the Defendants from terminating his SEVIS record, and requiring them to reactivate his SEVIS record so he may resume his Optional Practical Training (OPT). He also asks that the Court enjoin Defendants from detaining him and transferring him outside the jurisdiction of this Court. As further explained in Plaintiff's memorandum in support, a TRO is necessary because Plaintiff is experiencing existing restrictions and harm as a direct result of the Defendants' actions, and is subject to immediate arrest as Defendants consider him to be unlawfully in the United States. Mr. Chatwani requests an emergency hearing as soon as possible to present his motion for a TRO.
