Dear Sir/Ma'am;



Ultimately, there are material evidence that were willfully withheld from me by government agencies here in the U.S., that would substantiate my claims in the current immigration proceedings. Furthermore, a need for an investigation into my complaints is crucial too. I am being oppressed in the legal sense of the term: oppression.

Finally, challenging the facts of my custody, length of time in detention, as well as multiple petition I made to resolve this issue is pivotal. Thus, obtaining legal help will achieve these objectives.
