**NOTICE**

Petitioner Yostin Sleiker Gutierrez-Contreras hereby informs the Court that the above-entitled case is related to *Gutierrez-Contreras v. Warden, et al.*, 5:25-cv-911-SSS (KES) (C.D. Cal. 2025). See L.R. 83-1.3.1.

The above-entitled cases are related because the matters involve a petitioner and respondents in common and might entail substantial duplication of labor and judicial effort if heard by different judges. Specifically, the cases stem from the same set of operative facts, namely, respondents' placement of petitioner in immigration custody and respondents' potential expulsion of petitioner from the United States under the supposed authority of the Alien Enemies Act and in the absence of lawful removal order issued under the Immigration and Nationality Act. In addition, the related cases involve petitioner's same requested relief under 28 U.S.C. § 2241 and for a temporary restraining order prohibiting respondents' expulsion of petitioner unless and until a removal order is properly entered against him. In *Gutierrez-Contreras*, 5:25-cv-911-SSS (KES), on April 17, 2025, the Court issued a clarified temporary restraining order based on substantially similar facts as the presented request here. As explained in the instant petition, this petition is being filed as a protective measure to moot any jurisdictional or venue objections to the prior petition; although respondents moved petitioner out of this district just before the prior petition was filed, respondent has been returned to the Central District as of the filing of the instant petition.

Judicial economy would be best served if petitioner's claims were heard by the same judicial officer.
