PETITIONER'S BRIEFING REGARDING CUSTODY STATUS

On Friday, June 20th, 2025, this Court ordered the parties to notify the Court as to whether the Petitioner remains in ICE custody in El Paso, Texas. That afternoon, staff of C.R. Wannamaker Law, physically visited the detention center at 8995 Montana Avenue in El Paso, Texas and verified that Petitioner was still detained in that location.

On June 22, 2025, Counsel Lauren O'Neal received an email from Petitioner's detention officer confirming that Petitioner remains detained in El Paso, Texas. (See attached as exhibit A).

Accordingly, Petitioner is still detained in El Paso, Texas and this cause should not be dismissed.
