STATUS REPORT

Respondents provide the following Status Report as directed by this Court.

- Petitioner remains in Respondents custody at the ICE ERO Burlington (MA) Field Office.
- ICE ERO is continuing to work with the relevant agencies to determine appropriate placement for Petitioner in Office of Refugee Resettlement custody. Because of the criminal allegations against Petitioner, there does not appear to be ORR space in Massachusetts. This Court's jurisdiction over Petitioner's habeas petition would not be affected, however, if Petitioner was transferred out of the district.
- ICE ERO is in the process of seeking more information regarding Petitioner's May 8, 2025 criminal arrest and whether the state intends to prosecute Petitioner for the state charges. ICE attempted to obtain information from the state court, but was told the records were sealed due to his juvenile status.
- U.S. Citizenship and Immigration Services issued a Notice of Intent to Terminate Petitioner's deferred action status on May 9, 2025.
- ICE issued Petitioner with a Notice to Appear in removal proceedings in Immigration Court on May 9, 2025.
- Respondents will provide further updates to the Court as received.
