STATUS UPDATE

On June 24, 2025, this Court ordered Respondent to provide the Court with information regarding the efforts of the Department of Homeland Security ("DHS") to identify a third country or countries that will accept Petitioner Dorian Abad Ambrosi based on the order of removal. Doc. 20. The Court also ordered Respondent to describe the expected timeline for a decision and/or removal itself.

DHS, along with Immigrations and Customs Enforcement ("ICE"), has been actively working to identify an appropriate third country for Petitioner's removal. The applicable law is found in 8 U.S.C. § 1231(b)(1)(C) and 8 C.F.R. § 241.15, which together provide ICE's framework for identifying appropriate third countries for Petitioner's removal. The process generally involves ICE identifying viable countries for third country removal and issuing Request for Acceptance of Alien to the respective country's consulate. ICE then waits for confirmation from that country's consulate as to whether the country will or will not permit the alien's entry into the country upon his removal from the United States.

Here, ICE has identified and also contacted three countries who were potential candidates for the Petitioner's removal. All three countries denied those requests to accept Petitioner. ICE is diligently working to identify additional candidate countries for Petitioner's removal; however, as of today's date, neither DHS nor ICE have identified a country to which Petitioner is expected to be removed.

As of the date of this filing, DHS does not have an expected timeline for Petitioner's removal to a third country.
