RESPONDENTS' STATUS REPORT

Pursuant to the Court's directive Respondents provide a Status Report as follows:

On May 28, 2025, Counsel for Petitioner notified undersigned counsel for Federal Defendants that Petitioner Luis Antonio Guaman Guaman ("Petitioner") was being transferred out of this District, despite the Court's Order that ICE provide 72 hours' notice before any transfer take place. Undersigned counsel immediately reached out to ICE counsel, who after checking on Petitioner's status, confirmed that ICE accidentally transferred Petitioner out of New Hampshire that day, and that Petitioner was on an airplane en route to an ICE facility outside of this District. ICE counsel stated that this was simply a case of human error and there was no deliberate intent to ignore the Court's Order. ICE counsel informed the undersigned counsel on May 28 that ICE is currently arranging for Petitioner's return from Port Isabel Detention Center in Texas to New Hampshire and to Strafford County House of Corrections. Today, ICE counsel

informed the undersigned counsel today that ICE expects for Petitioner to depart for the Boston Area of Responsibility on May 31, 2025, with a final destination of Strafford County House of Corrections. ICE counsel further stated that ICE will be unable to facilitate a video appearance of the Petitioner for his bond hearing currently scheduled for May 29, 2025. However, ICE is willing to proceed with the hearing in Petitioner's absence should his immigration counsel agree. If not, ICE will not object to a continuance to the immigration judge's first available date next week for another bond hearing.
