**RESPONDENT’S RESPONSE IN OPPOSITION TO PETITIONER’S APPLICATION
FOR WRIT OF HABEAS CORPUS, MOTION TO DISMISS OR ALTERNATIVELY TO
STAY PROCEEDINGS**

Respondents, through undersigned counsel Thomas Corcoran, Assistant United States Attorney for the District of Maryland, oppose Petitioner’s Application Writ of Habeas Corpus and request that it be denied. Further, the Respondents move to dismiss, or in the alternative to stay, the Petition on the grounds that the Petitioner is a class member in a nationwide class certified in *D.V.D. v U.S. Department of Homeland Security*, ECF 118, 64 and 6-1 Civ. 25-10676-BEM (D. Mass. April 18 and May 21, 2025) (“*D.V.D. Memorandum and Order*”) and the procedures governing third country removals, such as the instant case, have already been ordered.

WHEREFORE, the Respondents respectfully request this Court enter an Order DENYING Petitioner’s Application for Writ of Habeas Corpus, and an Order DISMISSING or alternatively STAYING Petitioner’s Application for Writ of Habeas Corpus.
