JOINT STATUS REPORT

Pursuant to the Court's August 19, 2025 Order (ECF No. 28), the Parties provide the following status report.

1. Petitioner received a custody review from ICE on August 22, 2025. Prior to the custody review, Petitioner's counsel provided documents to ICE for consideration, including several letters of support from family, business associates, and community members, as well as business documents such as business license, bank statements, and contractor's licenses, proof of federal and state taxes paid, and title to real and other property owned during the custody review. It is unclear how ICE completed the custody review, and whether they confirmed receipt and consideration of the documents sent by Petitioner's counsel. ICE never contacted Petitioner's counsel, and it is unclear whether ICE interviewed the Petitioner. Nevertheless, the result of the custody review was that the Petitioner is to remain in custody.

2. Furthermore, Petitioner has, to date, not received a credible fear interview (CFI) from ICE.

3. To the extent this Court wants additional briefing on the issue of Respondent's revocation of Petitioner's Order of Supervision (as raised in Petitioner's Sur-Reply (ECF 27)), Respondents can provide it.
