In the habeas petition, request for temporary restraining order, and the supplement to the motion for preliminary injunction, the Petitioner represented that he had not been arrested or convicted of any crime after his release from custody. On June 6, 2025, an Immigration and Customs Enforcement officer served the Petitioner with a Notice of Revocation of Release. See Exhibit 1- Notice of Revocation of Release. For the first time since the Petitioner's May 21, 2025 detention, ICE provided a reason for revoking the noncitizen's supervision. Specifically, ICE stated that the

Petitioner had been convicted under <u>California Vehicle Code section</u> 23152(b). *Id*.

Undersigned counsel was unaware of this fact at the time the habeas and related filings were filed. After receiving the Notice of Revocation of Release, undersigned counsel verified that the Petitioner was convicted in 2014 for violating California Vehicle Code section 23152(b). See Exhibit B-Superior Court of California Case Printout. Undersigned counsel apologizes to this court for not knowing this fact before filing the habeas petition and assures the court that not knowing this fact was unintentional.
