20	The parties, through their respective counsel of record, respectfully submit this	
21	joint status report and request the Court stay proceedings for an additional 30 days. See	
22	ECF No. 16. The Court has already granted two extensions on June 18, 2025 and July	
23	2, 2025. This marks the parties third extension request. The parties requested in their	
24	July 2, 2025, Joint Status Report (ECF No. 15) that the matter continue to be stayed to	
25	allow time for ICE to cancel Petitioner's expedited removal order and issue Petitione	
26	a new Notice to Appear (NTA), for Petitioner to file a new asylum application (I-589)	
27	and for Petitioner to potentially seek a new bond hearing before an immigration judge	
28		

The parties noted that if the habeas petition is not dismissed by August 1, 2025, the parties would file another joint status report. Id.

The parties are continuing the work towards an extrajudicial resolution of the habeas petition. On July 1, 2025, Petitioner's expedited removal order was canceled and ICE served Petitioner a new Notice to Appear, placing her back into Section 1229a removal proceedings. Now that Section 1229a proceedings have resumed, Petitioner has refiled her asylum application (Form I-589), and she has moved an immigration judge to redetermine her custody, asserting that ICE is detaining her under 8 U.S.C. § 1226(a) and not 8 U.S.C. § 1225(b). Yesterday, on July 30, 2025, an immigration judge scheduled her custody redetermination hearing for 1 p.m. on August 8, 2025.

The parties request an additional 30 days to include the Labor Day weekend, up to and including Tuesday, September 2, 2025, to continue working towards an extrajudicial resolution of the habeas petition. They will file a new status report on September 2, 2025, if the habeas petition is not dismissed by that date.
