NOTICE OF VOLUNTARY DISMISSAL

Pursuant to Rule of Civil Procedure 41(a)(1)(A)(i) of the Federal Rules of Civil Procedure, Plaintiff, by and through his attorney, respectfully submits this Notice of Voluntary Dismissal, for all claims raised in his petition. Plaintiff was transferred, either yesterday or earlier today, from the El Paso Service Processing Center to the Houston Contract Detention Facility, an immigrant facility operated on behalf of the U.S. Immigration and Customs Enforcement. Undersigned counsel first learned of this transfer this afternoon, after the Court had granted the requested admission *pro hac vice* of attorney Scott A. Emerick. Considering this development, Mr. Daryani's petition for habeas corpus is pending before the wrong U.S. District Court.

The Petitioner asks that his claims be dismissed without prejudice, with each party to bear their own costs and fees, so he can refile his petition with the U.S. District Court for the Southern District of Texas.
