## STIPULATION OF DISMISSAL

Pursuant to Federal Rule of Civil Procedure 41(a)(1)(A)(ii), Petitioner and Respondents hereby notify the Court that they stipulate to dismissal of this case. Petitioner's habeas petition is now moot because she has been released from federal custody and removed to Honduras, and there are no continuing collateral consequences from the challenged detention decision.

Respondents further state in response to the Court's text order [Doc. No. 15] that the Court's subject matter jurisdiction was not impacted - that is, the Court retained jurisdiction after Petitioner was moved out of the Western District of Kentucky and while she remained in federal custody. See White v. Lamanna, 42 F. App'x 670, 671 (6th Cir. 2002).

WHEREFORE, the Court is informed that each party herein agrees to bear their own costs, expenses, and attorneys' fees.
