**STIPULATION OF DISMISSAL**

In this civil action, Petitioner alleged that although he was subject to discretionary detention pursuant to 8 U.S.C. § 1226(a), Immigration and Customs Enforcement erroneously labeled him an “arriving alien,” which deprived him of an opportunity for bond. *See generally* Pet. (Dkt 1). Petitioner appeared before an immigration judge (“IJ”) on April 22, 2025 for a bond hearing, and the IJ granted bond.

Accordingly, the parties hereby stipulate and agree that the action be dismissed without prejudice pursuant to Federal Rule of Civil Procedure 41(a)(1)(A)(ii), each party to bear its own costs, attorney’s fees, and expenses.
