RESPONDENTS' MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME TO FILE RESPONSIVE PLEADING (UNOPPOSED)

Respondents, by and through, Nicholas J. Ganjei, United States Attorney for the Southern District of Texas, respectfully move this Court to grant them an extension of time to file their answer to *Petitioner's Petition for Writ of Habeas Corpus* ("Petition"). In support of this motion, Respondents submit:

- On April 21, 2025, Petitioner filed his Petition alleging that he was being illegally detained by Respondents. The Petition was originally filed in the Western District of Texas (WDTX). (ECF 1)
- After the Petition was filed, it was determined that the WDTX did not have jurisdiction over Petitioner as he was being held in the custody of Respondents at the El Valle Detention Center located in Raymondville, Texas – within the jurisdiction of the Southern District of Texas (SDTX). (ECF 11 and 12)
- 3. As such, the WDTX court issued an Order transferring the case to the SDTX. (ECF 12)
- 4. While the case was pending in the WDTX, summons' were issued and served on Respondents. The United States Attorney's Office in the WDTX was served on May 19, 2025. *In lieu* of a responsive pleading, the USAO in the WDTX moved for a change of venue. Had the USAO not filed a motion for a change of venue, Respondents'

Answer/Responsive pleading herein would be due on July 18, 2025.

5. In addition, it is the understanding of the undersigned counsel for the government that a

hearing is scheduled to take place in immigration court on July 21, 2025. It is anticipated

that the outcome of this hearing will likely impact how this case would or should proceed.

6. Counsel for Respondents respectfully seek an extension of this deadline to a date to be

established by the Court at the July 22, 2025, status hearing. By this point in time, it is

likely that the parties will know the outcome of the immigration court hearing and they will

be better able to address any remaining issues.

7. Consequently, Respondents request they not be required to file a formal response until such

time as this Court deems necessary at the July 22, 2025, hearing.

PRAYER

Respondents pray that this Court grant this motion and allow Respondents sufficient time

to formulate their response and establish a Response/Answer due date at the July 22, 2025, Status

Hearing in this matter.
