**STIPULATION OF DISMISSAL**

Petitioner, Kevin Edgardo Ramirez Solis, by and through his counsel Jacob C. Rourk of Ramirez-Smith Law, and stipulated to by Respondents by and through their counsel Michael W. Mitchell, respectfully file this Motion to Dismiss Petitioner’s Habeas Corpus claim.

1. After the Portland Immigration Court determined that Petitioner was ineligible for bond, and subject to mandatory detention under 8 U.S.C. 1225(b), he was subsequently transferred from ICE custody in Mountain Home, Idaho to ICE custody in Pahrump, Nevada.

2. Petitioner submitted another motion for a bond hearing to the Las Vegas Immigration Court, which has jurisdiction over bond cases for aliens physically detained in Pahrump.
3. The Las Vegas court scheduled him for a bond hearing on August 12, 2025. On that date, the judge assigned to the hearing concluded that Petitioner was subject to 8 U.S.C. 1226(a), and thus eligible for bond, his entry without inspection notwithstanding. The judge granted Petitioner bond in the amount of \$5,500.
4. Proceedings before this court are mooted, Petitioner being now released from detention. As such, Petitioner and Respondents agree to and request the court's dismissal of this case.
