with the Immigration Court based on Respondent's Fear of Persecution or Torture in

Mexico. If the removal proceeding with the Immigration Court are reopened, the

Petitioner may be eligible to petition for a bond.

5. On July 29, 2025, this Honorable Court ordered a Joint Status update to be filed on

August 12, 2025.

6. On August 12, the Petitioner filed a Joint Status Request and Petition to Set a New Status

Update, with no opposition from the Respondent, due to the fact that the Motion to

Reopen with the Immigration Judge was still pending. The Honorable Judge set a new

status report deadline of August 26, 2025.

7. As of today, the Motion to Reopen with the Immigration Court is still pending. Counsel

for Petitioner has been in contact with the Immigration Court who has indicated that the

Judge has been experiencing a very large number of cases added to his docket but will try

to have a ruling as soon as possible.

8. The Respondent does not oppose the setting of a new Status Report date.

WHEREFORE, the Petitioner without opposition from the Respondents respectfully

requests that this Honorable Court grant and set a new status report with a deadline of two weeks

from today, September 9, 2025.
