On June 24, without any explantion, I was transported to South louisiana. Is soon as we arrived we were given only an orange uniform withour my warm clothes land T-skirts we were also not aslowed to keep warm clothes from Richwood, and it as lowed to keep warm clothes from kichwood and it was very cold to sleep in the dorm and the officers retused to adjust the temperature. On July 15 I was given a document canceling the parale Jwith Flight isk. On July 21st my mother personally came to my TCE officer a sked him to accept my sponsorship package and request for a parale so that I could be relegised, but he refused then my mother asked to send me my interview from the border and detention, since I requested it through a request and from local ICE officers that they refused to send it to me I feer my mother having refused to send it to me defen my mother farrive they gave me my interview that same day and an leder 25th these again sent me a refusal of the parole. On July 23rd my first master heaving took place aftere I asked for more time to trind a lawyer. I explained that we did not have enough maskey to hire a lawyer, and they give me a listel of dumbers of free Clawyers. It was very difficult to get through to these numbers, it took me about a month but uat a single organization dealt only with members of LGBTQ + community and HIV patients, and the athers answered that they do not provide lawyers, they can only send met information on holding court in detention.

Throughout the entite time in South Couisiana there were big problems with treatment when I is hed for medications, they answered that they were not govered by detention in sur ance and

intest these goods were 11 not available I was not given proper psychological help. The pills that he psychiatrist presenthed me have a side ffect - thoughts, of suicide.
