Dear Judge Wang:

This Office represents the government in the above-referenced action brought pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 2241, in which Petitioner has challenged his detention by U.S. Immigration and Customs Enforcement (“ICE”). I write, jointly with Petitioner, to provide the Court with a status update regarding this matter. I apologize for the delay in filing this update, which was due on August 20, 2025. *See* ECF Nos. 16-17.

As the parties previously informed the Court, the parties stipulated in July 2025 that the government would provide Petitioner with a bond hearing before an immigration judge, and that hearing was held on August 1, 2025. ECF Nos. 10, 13, 15. At that hearing, the immigration judge granted Petitioner release on a \$5,000 bond, which Petitioner tendered, and Petitioner was released from ICE custody on August 6, 2025. ECF Nos. 15-16. Because ICE released Petitioner with an ankle monitor, Petitioner availed himself of his administrative remedies and requested the immigration judge to ameliorate that condition of his release. ECF No. 16. On August 13, 2025, the immigration judge granted Petitioner’s motion to ameliorate. *Id.* Since then, ICE removed Petitioner’s ankle monitor on August 15, 2025, and Petitioner has now agreed to voluntarily dismiss the case. The parties filed a notice of voluntary dismissal today. *See* ECF No. 18.

The parties thank the Court for its consideration of this letter.
