Joint Motion to Dismiss

The United States, on behalf of Respondents, and Petitioner, jointly move to dismiss the pending action without prejudice. As grounds, the parties aver that Petitioner requested redetermination of bond from an immigration judge pursuant to his administratively available remedies. A bond hearing was conducted July 24, 2025, and Petitioner was granted release on \$10,000 bond with conditions. Petitioner subsequently posted bond and was released from custody July 28, 2025. Accordingly, the petition should be dismissed.
