The federal respondents, Donald J. Trump, in his official capacity as President of the United States; Pamela Bondi, in her official capacity as United States Attorney General; Kristi Noem, in her official capacity as Secretary of the United States Department of Homeland Security; Todd Lyons, in his official capacity as Acting Director and Senior Official Performing the Duties of the Director, United States Immigration and Customs Enforcement; Pete Hegseth, in his official capacity as Secretary of Defense; Sam Olson¹, in his official capacity as the Acting St. Paul Field Office Director for United States Immigration and Customs Enforcement, hereby submit this status report to the Court pursuant to the Court's Order (ECF 17).

As of August 19, 2025, when the parties filed their last status updates to the Court, the credible fear process had been completed, and ICE was able to begin planning to

execute Mr. Banyee's removal order to Liberia. ICE has identified a date within the next six weeks and is working on logistical matters to be able to remove Mr. Banyee during that timeframe. As set forward in our responsive briefing, ICE has a valid travel document for Banyee and progress is being made towards his removal. Response at pp. 26-28.

The parties have met and conferred in advance of the United States submitting this status report and have agreed to propose to the Court that a status update be filed in six weeks.
