Comes the Petitioner Omid Delkash, through undersigned counsel with this Notice of Eligibility for Naturalization under <u>8 U.S.C.</u> § 1440. Mr. Delkash now has a pending naturalization application with DHS under Section 1440. See Exhibit A-Receipt Notice of the Naturalization Application under <u>8 U.S.C. § 1440</u>. The statute permits naturalization for active duty servicemembers during certain armed conflicts. The designated periods of hostilities include service during the Persian

Gulf Conflict. See <u>8 C.F.R.</u> § 329.2. Mr. Delkash honorably served during this period. See <u>Exhibit B- D-2214</u>, Certificate of Release from Active Duty, and Honorable Discharge Order. An order of removal does not disqualify Mr. Delkash from naturalization under section 1440.

In addition, Mr. Delkash's immigration attorney reviewed Petitioner's criminal record after being informed that the Petitioner was arrested earlier this year on suspicion of violating a restraining order. *See* Dckt. 11, p. 1 and AUSA at oral argument. However, at the time of Mr. Delkash's warrantless arrest by ICE, the Irvine Police Department had already declined prosecution of the charge, citing that is "[c]annot prove [guilt] beyond a reasonable doubt." *See* Exhibit C- Irvine Police Declining Prosecution Letter. There are no impediments to DHS granting Mr. Delkash's naturalization application.
