**PETITIONER'S RESPONSE TO
RESPONDENTS' OBJECTIONS**

Note on Motion Calendar: November 12,
2025

On October 28, 2025, Chief Magistrate Judge Theresa Fricke recommended that Petitioner Abderrahim Belqasim received a bond hearing before an immigration judge (IJ) where Immigration and Customs Enforcement be required to prove by clear and convincing evidence that Mr. Belqasim is a flight risk or danger to the community. Dkt. 17. Respondents have not filed substantive objections to the report and recommendation (R&R), and instead request that they be provided fourteen days to schedule the bond hearing, instead of seven. *See* Dkt. 18. The Court should reject that request, adopt the R&R, and order a hearing within seven days. Given that Defendants have not filed any substantive objections to the R&R, they are already aware of their upcoming obligation to schedule an interpreter for a bond hearing. Thus, they have already

1 had two weeks (since the date of the R&R) to begin those preparations, in addition to the seven
2 days laid out in the R&R from the date of this Court’s forthcoming order.

3 For these reasons, Petitioner asks that the Court adopt the R&R in full at the earliest
4 available opportunity.
