Ronal Estuardo Gutierrez-Ramos was detained by the US Coast Guard at sea on 06/09/2025 without a judicial warrant. He was later taken into custody by DHS/ICE and held in detention at the Plymouth Correctional Facility. Transfer out of Massachusetts would inhibit his access to counsel and prevent his pursuit of immigration relief. We are concerned about his physical wellbeing as he was denied access to commissary food that was ordered and fear an imminent transfer out of this jurisdiction.


