1. This matter is set for a status hearing on Wednesday, July 30, 2025 at 10:00 a.m.
2. The Court had extended the temporary restraining order in this case until such time as the Immigration Court had ruled on this issue of bond, or custody redetermination in the Immigration Court.

3. On July 28, 2025, the Immigration Court issued the attached order, finding that the Immigration Court was without jurisdiction to reconsider custody. (attached)
4. The decision by the Immigration Judge fulfills the relief sought by Plaintiff in this matter.
5. Plaintiff has sought other relief before this Court, in Case No. 1:25-cv-510-SJD. That matter remains pending.

WHEREFORE, in light of the foregoing, Plaintiff asks this Court for a voluntary dismissal of this action.


