
My name is Samir Abu el HAJ. I was born in Qatar D.O.B [REDACTED]

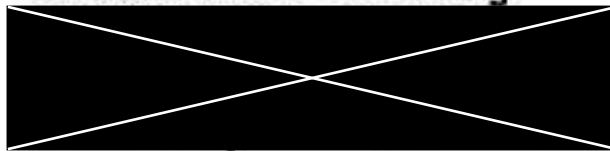
