

I am a paralegal and director of Fundación para la Dignidad del Inmigrante, a nonprofit organization that provides legal support to immigrants in detention. I am currently in the process of obtaining full DOJ accreditation to represent individuals before the Executive Office for

Immigration Review (EOIR). I am not submitting this petition in the capacity of legal counsel or attorney. I have simply facilitated the preparation of this document by transcribing the facts and requests made directly by Mr. Juárez, who is acting pro se in asserting his right to judicial review of his ongoing detention. Mr. Juárez is also in the process of preparing an application for T nonimmigrant status (Visa T) due to factors related to trafficking and exploitation, and we are actively working on that case as of today.
