On July 24, 2025, Petitioner Phong Thanh Nguyen filed a petition for writ of habeas corpus and motion for a temporary restraining order ("TRO") against Respondents to challenge his re-detention at the Northwest Immigration and Customs Enforcement ("ICE") Processing Center. Dkts. 1 and 2. Respondents filed their opposition to the TRO on July 26, 2025. Dkt. 13. A hearing was held on July 29, 2025, on the TRO, and at that hearing, the court ordered all parties to meet and confer to discuss a briefing schedule on a motion for a preliminary injunction ("PI") and hearing date for the PI.
