PETITIONER'S REQUEST FOR JUDICIAL NOTICE

**REGARDING ALTERED CUSTODY REVIEW DOCUMENT AND
MATERIAL DEFICIENCY IN ADMINISTRATIVE RECORD**

COMES NOW Petitioner, Jidier Antonio Saavedra, appearing pro se, and pursuant to **Rule 201 of the Federal Rules of Evidence**, respectfully provides this Notice to the Court concerning significant irregularities and procedural deficiencies affecting the integrity of the administrative record now under review in this habeas corpus proceeding.

Petitioner recently received a document purporting to represent a 90-day Post-Order Custody Review, which contains handwritten alterations, conflicting dates, and was generated after the filing of the present habeas petition. No actual 90-day review was ever conducted in Petitioner's case. Instead, Petitioner underwent a

180-day Post-Order Custody Review, the outcome of which has not been provided to Petitioner, nor has ICE confirmed its transmittal to headquarters in Washington, D.C., despite prior assurances.

The record now includes a document that misrepresents the actual timeline and nature of the review process, thereby prejudicing Petitioner's ability to seek effective judicial relief. These irregularities create a defective administrative record, potentially violate Petitioner's due process rights under the Fifth Amendment, and obstruct the Court's ability to fairly review the lawfulness of Petitioner's continued detention. Such deficiencies warrant judicial notice under Fed. R. Evid. 201(b), as they are not subject to reasonable dispute and are capable of accurate determination.


WHEREFORE, Petitioner respectfully requests that this Honorable Court:

- Take judicial notice of the materially altered and inaccurate document labeled as a "90-day custody review" now appearing in the record;
- Direct the Respondent to confirm in writing whether a proper 180-day custody review was conducted and transmitted to ICE Headquarters, and to provide Petitioner with a clean, unaltered copy of said decision;

- Require Respondent to file an accurate and complete administrative record, including all custody review decisions and transmission logs relevant to the present habeas matter;
- Grant any further relief this Court deems just and appropriate under the circumstances.

This request is made in good faith to preserve the integrity of these proceedings and to ensure a complete and truthful record in a matter implicating Petitioner's detention and liberty interests.


