Status Report to the Court

Federal Respondents provide the following status report as ordered by the Court. ECF No. 27.

1. The status of the request for travel documents for Madhoun with Israel. ICE's request for Israel to grant permission for Petitioner to transit from the Ben Gurion Airport in Tel Aviv to the West Bank or Gaza remains pending. ICE's request to Israel included all the information the State of Israel typically requires for approval. Exh. A at 2, 3.
2. Whether in calendar year 2025, any requests for travel documents on behalf of Palestinian nationals have been made to Israel, and if so, a) how many requests were made; b) what percentage, if any, have been granted; and c) for any granted requests, the time between request and approval. In 2025, ICE requested permission from the Israeli government for 54 Palestinian Nationals to cross from Israel to the West Bank/Gaza. Exh. A at 3. Since January 2025, at least 6 Palestinian nationals were removed with permission from the Israeli government. *Id.*
3. The status of any third country removal efforts, including but not limited to whether any requests for travel documents have been made with other countries on Madhoun's behalf and whether, when, and to which countries additional requests will be sent. ICE El Paso will not initiate third country removal efforts until Israel denies permission to cross Petitioner to the West Bank/Gaza. *See* Exh. A at 3.
4. Any other efforts by Respondents to remove Madhoun from the United States. No additional efforts to remove Madhoun have been made. *See generally*, Exh. A.
