Pursuant to Rule 65(b) of the Federal Rules of Civil Procedure and Rule 231 of the Local rules of this Court, Petitioner hereby move the Court for emergency relief in the form of a temporary restraining order directing Respondents to release Petitioner from their custody until he is afforded a hearing as required by the Due Process clause of the Fifth Amendment, to determine whether the government can justify the necessity of his reincarceration by clear and convincing evidence, or in the alternative, to provide Petitioner with an individualized bond hearing before an immigration judge pursuant within seven days of issuance of an Order.

Petitioner also seeks a temporary restraining order enjoining Respondents from relocating

Petitioner outside of the Eastern District of California pending final resolution of this case.

This application is supported by the Memorandum of Points and Authorities, the Declaration of Lydia Sinkus with accompanying exhibits, as well as any additional submissions that may be considered by the Court. As set forth in the Points and Authorities in support of this Motion, Mr. Cuevas Guzman raises that he warrants a temporary restraining order due to his weighty liberty interest under the Due Process Clause of the Fifth Amendment in remedying his unlawful re-incarceration, which was imposed absent a pre-deprivation due process hearing, and in light of his unlawful continued detention without a bond hearing, in violation of his statutory rights under the Immigration and Nationality Act.
