Motion for Appointment of Counsel Under 18 U.S.C. § 3006A(a)(2)(B)

Simultaneously with this document, Mr. Malitskyi has filed a petition for a writ of habeas corpus under 28 U.S.C. § 2241. In his petition, he asserts that because of the war between Ukraine and Russia, his removal to Ukraine is not likely in the foreseeable future, such that his continued detention by immigration officials violates the Fifth Amendment's Due Process Clause. Because he is almost certain to prevail on this claim, he respectfully asks the Court to appoint Assistant Federal Public Defender Keith Hilzendeger to assist him in litigating his petition. Mr. Hilzendeger has spoken with Mr. Malitskyi, and reports that Mr. Malitskyi has agreed to accept representation if the Court should appoint counsel.

Under 18 U.S.C. § 3006A(a)(2)(B), this Court may appoint counsel for any person seeking relief under 28 U.S.C. § 2241. Mr. Malitskyi is seeking relief under that provision. The Ninth Circuit has said that a court should appoint counsel under this provision if the petitioner is likely to succeed on his petition and to have difficulty "articulat[ing] his claims *pro se* in light of the complexity of the legal issues involved." Weygandt v. Look, 718 F.2d 952, 954 (9th Cir. 1983)

(per curiam). Mr. Malitskyi came to the United States in 2024 under the Biden-era "Uniting for Ukraine" program, under which the U.S. government agreed to resettle up to 100,000 Ukrainians displaced by the war with Russia who had passed stringent screening criteria. He does not speak English, and so he does not read English. (Both Russian and Ukrainian, his preferred languages, are written in slightly different versions of the Cyrillic alphabet.) For these reasons, he does not have the wherewithal to litigate this complex challenge to his indefinite detention by immigration officials on his own from a jail cell where he does not have the documentation necessary to refute the government's case for continued detention. And for the reasons set forth in the motion for a preliminary injunction, he is almost certain to succeed on his claim. Mr. Malitskyi thus respectfully asks the Court to appoint Assistant Federal Public Defender Keith Hilzendeger to assist him in this matter.
