**JOINT STATUS REPORT**

Pursuant to the Court's order entered on November 6, 2025, the Parties file this advisory to inform the Court regarding Petitioner's removal proceedings. *See* ECF No. 19.

1. On November 12, 2025, ICE denied Petitioner's parole request.
2. Despite applying for an immigration bond hearing, on November 4, 2025, the immigration court denied Petitioner's bond request due to lack of jurisdiction under *Matter of Yajure Hurtado*, 29 I&N Dec. 216 (BIA 2025). *See* Attachment.
3. At present, Petitioner's Form I-589 application for asylum and related relief from removal is still pending a final merits date with the immigration court.
4. Petitioner, through counsel, pled to the NTA and conceded all factual allegations and the charge of removal. An application for asylum I-589 was filed, but Petitioner, through counsel, requested more time to get translation of documents to support the claim.
5. Currently, Petitioner is scheduled for another master calendar hearing on December 19, 2025. This hearing is to calendar the final merits hearing.
