DECLARATION OF RYAN LANKFORD

In accordance with the provisions of Section 1746 of Title 28, United States Code, I, the undersigned, Ryan J. Lankford, do hereby make the following declaration, under penalty of perjury in the above-styled and numbered cause:

1. I, Ryan J. Lankford, am presently employed by the United States Department of Homeland Security, Immigration and Customs Enforcement (“DHS”), in the position of Deportation Officer for Enforcement Removal Operations (“ERO”).
2. My duties as a Deportation Officer include the review of alien files and monitoring the custody status of aliens who have a final order of removal. In carrying out this duty, I am responsible for monitoring the progress of obtaining travel documents necessary for removing aliens to the designated country of removal. As a Deportation Officer, I have access to records maintained in the ordinary course of business by ICE.
3. I am familiar with the case of Seyed Ali MOUSAVI, alien file number XXXXXXXXXX, a native and citizen of Iran. My involvement with MOUSAVI’s case has included monitoring his detention history.
4. On or about July 18, 2024, MOUSAVI applied for admission to the United States at San Ysidro, California. He did not have a valid entry document as required by the

Immigration and Nationality Act. MOUSAVI was placed into immigration proceedings with the issuance of a Notice to Appear.

5. On July 25, 2025, MOUSAVI reported to the ERO Oklahoma City, Oklahoma office for his check-in. At that time, ERO detained him and placed him in the Tulsa County Jail. The Tulsa County Jail is a short-term detention space for DHS. MOUSAVI remained at the Tulsa County Jail until August 19, 2025, when he was transferred to the Bluebonnet Detention Center in Anson, Texas. On August 26, 2025, MOUSAVI was transferred to the Karnes County Immigration Processing Center in Karnes City, Texas.
6. On July 25, 2025, when MOUSAVI was transferred to the Tulsa County Jail, ERO mistakenly listed MOUSAVI's new address as the Bluebonnet Detention Center in Anson, Texas. The El Paso Immigration Court has jurisdiction over the Bluebonnet Detention Center cases, so MOUSAVI's case was docketed in the El Paso Immigration Court. However, MOUSAVI was not transferred to the Bluebonnet Detention Center until August 19, 2025.
7. On August 27, 2025, ERO filed a notice on the court docket that MOUSAVI is now detained at the Karnes County Immigration Processing Center in Karnes City, Texas. ERO transferred MOUSAVI to the Karnes County Processing Center to manage the number of detainees at the Bluebonnet Detention Center and ensure it does not become overcrowded.

Notice to Respondent

Warning: Any statement you make may be used against you in removal proceedings.

Alien Registration: This copy of the Notice to Appear served upon you is evidence of your alien registration while you are in removal proceedings. You are required to carry it with you at all times.

Representation: If you so choose, you may be represented in this proceeding, at no expense to the Government, by an attorney or other individual authorized and qualified to represent persons before the Executive Office for Immigration Review, pursuant to 8 CFR 1003.16. Unless you so request, no hearing will be scheduled earlier than ten days from the date of this notice, to allow you sufficient time to secure counsel. A list of qualified attorneys and organizations who may be available to represent you at no cost will be provided with this notice.

Conduct of the hearing: At the time of your hearing, you should bring with you any affidavits or other documents that you desire to have considered in connection with your case. If you wish to have the testimony of any witnesses considered, you should arrange to have such witnesses present at the hearing. At your hearing you will be given the opportunity to admit or deny any or all of the allegations in the Notice to Appear, including that you are inadmissible or removable. You will have an opportunity to present evidence on your own behalf, to examine any evidence presented by the Government, to object, on proper legal grounds, to the receipt of evidence and to cross examine any witnesses presented by the Government. At the conclusion of your hearing, you have a right to appeal an adverse decision by the immigration judge. You will be advised by the immigration judge before whom you appear of any relief from removal for which you may appear eligible including the privilege of voluntary departure. You will be given a reasonable opportunity to make any such application to the immigration judge.

One-Year Asylum Application Deadline: If you believe you may be eligible for asylum, you must file a Form 1-589, Application for Asylum and for Withholding of Removal. The Form 1-589, Instructions, and information on where to file the Form can be found at www.uscis.gov/i-589. Failure to file the Form 1-589 within one year of arrival may bar you from eligibility to apply for asylum pursuant to section 203(a)(2)(B) of the Immigration and Nationality Act.

Failure to appear: You are required to provide the Department of Homeland Security (DHS), in writing, with your full mailing address and telephone number. You must notify the Immigration Court and the DHS immediately by using Form EOIR-33 whenever you change your address or telephone number during the course of this proceeding. You will be provided with a copy of this form. Notices of hearing will be mailed to this address. If you do not submit Form EOIR-33 and do not otherwise provide an address at which you may be reached during proceedings, then the Government shall not be required to provide you with written notice of your hearing. If you fail to attend the hearing at the time and place designated on this notice, or any date and time later directed by the Immigration Court, a removal order may be made by the immigration judge in your absence, and you may be arrested and detained by the DHS.

Mandatory Duty to Surrender for Removal: If you become subject to a final order of removal, you must surrender for removal to your local DHS office, listed on the internet at http://www.ice.gov/contact/ero, as directed by the DHS and required by statute and regulation. Immigration regulations at 8 CFR 1241.1 define when the removal order becomes administratively final. If you are granted voluntary departure and fail to depart the United States as required, fail to post a bond in connection with voluntary departure, or fail to comply with any other condition or term in connection with voluntary departure, you must surrender for removal on the next business day thereafter. If you do not surrender for removal as required, you will be ineligible for all forms of discretionary relief for as long as you remain in the United States and for ten years after your departure or removal. This means you will be ineligible for asylum, cancellation of removal, voluntary departure, adjustment of status, change of nonimmigrant status, registry, and related waivers for this period. If you do not surrender for removal as required, you may also be criminally prosecuted under section 243 of the Immigration and Nationality Act.

U.S. Citizenship Claims: If you believe you are a United States citizen, please advise the DHS by calling the ICE Law Enforcement Support Center toll free at (855) 448-6903.

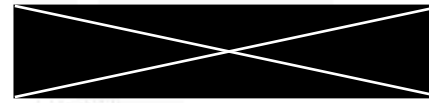




