Motion for Appointment of consel Pursuant to 18 U.S.C. § 3006A Petitioner Yokubov Abdulaziz has filed a petition for writ of habeas corpus under 28 U.S.C. § 2241 challenging Petitioner's indefinite detention by Respondents. Petitioner was detained by Immigration and Customs Enforcement (ICE) on or about (Date 01/27/2025) Golden State Annex Petitioner has remained in ICE custody since that date. Petitioner's removal proceedings remain pending.

The concurrently filed petition for writ of habeas corpus sets forth Petitioner's eligibility for a writ of habeas corpus ordering Petitioner's release.

Petitioner moves the Court to appoint counsel to represent Petitioner in this case.
