

3) Thus, Petitioner's arguments for release challenging the legality of the automatic stay regulations would be futile.

4) The Petitioner seeks to voluntarily dismiss the action, under Rule 41(a)(2), without prejudice.

5) Rule 41(a)(2) of the Federal Rules of Civil Procedure allows for dismissal by court order on terms the court considers proper unless the opposing party can show plain legal prejudice.

6) Respondents have stated no counterclaims and will be unable to demonstrate plain legal prejudice should this petition for Habeas Corpus be dismissed.

7) Because of changed circumstances, and because respondents in this case will not be prejudiced, Petitioner seeks an order granting voluntary dismissal.

WHEREFORE, PREMISES CONSIDERED, Petitioner respectfully requests that this Court grant this Motion for Voluntary Dismissal and dismiss this action without prejudice.
