Petitioner was ordered removed on September 7, 2018

Petitioner's appeal was dismissed on March 1, 2019

Government tried to deport petitioner to Ethiopia,

Petitioner was released in August of 2019 on supervision

Petitioner was re-detained on February 28, 2025

Government tried to deport petitioner to Eritrea

Petitioner fully cooperated with the government to obtain travel documents

petitioner gave fingerprints and signed all applications for travel documents from

Eritrean consulate.

Petitioner's status of custody was reviewed on May 24, 2025

Petitioner was given another custody review on July 28, 2025, in which the government stated petitioner's removability in foreseeable future is unlikely therefore will interview petitioner to determine release from custody.

Petitioner was given interview on August 11, 2025, during interview petitioner answered all questions consistent with previous reviews and informations.

Petitioner requested for copies of all custody reviews and interviews with the government Government did not respond to petitioner's request.

In conclusion the government has failed to deport me within the reasonable time allowed I want the court to order my release from detainment.
