## INTRODUCTION

Pursuant to Civil Local Rule 7-3(d)(2), Petitioners bring to the Court's attention a relevant judicial opinion published the same day Petitioner's temporary restraining order motion was submitted. The citation is *Espinoza v. Kaiser*, No. 1:25-CV-01101 JLT SKO, 2025 U.S. Dist. LEXIS 173694 (E.D. Cal. Sept. 5, 2025). The opinion is relevant because a court in this circuit recently refuted Respondents' position that Petitioners do not have a liberty interest because they are subject to mandatory position under 8 U.S.C. § 1225(b). *See id.* at \* 26-28.
