ORDER

In this action brought under 28 U.S.C. § 2241, Petitioner challenged her immigration detention, arguing on August 22, 2025, an Immigration Judge terminated Petitioner’s removal proceedings on the basis Petitioner “clearly and beyond a doubt entitled to admission to the United States and is not inadmissible as charged.” (Doc. 1 at 47.) With her Petition, Petitioner filed a Motion for Temporary Restraining Order and Preliminary Injunction. (Doc. 2.) The Court ordered expedited briefing of the motion for injunctive relief. (Doc. 6.)

On September 23, 2025, Petitioner filed a Notice of Supplemental Authority, indicating DHS failed to appeal the IJ’s order terminating proceedings against Petitioner, thereby removing any legal basis for her continued detention. (Doc. 19.) The Court directed Respondents to respond to Petitioner’s notice. (Doc. 20.) Respondents filed their response, indicating

[t]o the extent the government had previously argued in its Answer that detention was warranted under 8 U.S.C. § 1225(b)(2)(A), the government must now withdraw those arguments. As such, no removal proceedings are

currently active that can serve as a legal basis to continue detaining
Petitioner.

(Doc. 21.) Because Respondents acknowledge there is no legal basis to detain Petitioner,
the Court will grant her Petition and order her release from immigration detention.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDREED Petitioner's Petition for Writ of Habeas Corpus
(Doc. 1) is **granted**. Petitioner must be released from immigration custody immediately
under the same conditions that existed before her detention.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED all remaining motions are **denied as moot**.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED the Clerk of Court must enter judgment in
Petitioner's favor and close this case.
