ORDER

*Pro se* Petitioner Nisar Ahmad Hamidi is currently detained at Elizabeth Detention Center and appears to challenge his prolonged detention without a custody review hearing. He has not paid the \$5.00 filing fee or applied to proceed *in forma pauperis*. Local Civil Rule 81.2 provides:

If the petition or motion is presented *in forma pauperis* it shall include an affidavit (attached to the back of the form) setting forth information which establishes that the petitioner or movant is unable to pay the fees and costs of the proceedings.

L.Civ.R. 81.2(b). Prior to dismissing this case for failure to pay the filing fee, the Court will direct the Clerk of the Court to provide Petitioner a blank affidavit of poverty and provide Petitioner with the opportunity to submit a complete IFP application or the \$5.00 filing fee.

**THEREFORE**, it is on this 14 day November 2025;


**ORDERED** that the Clerk of the Court shall send Petitioner a blank Affidavit of Poverty, DNJ-Pro Se-007-B-(Rev. 09/09), and ADMINISTRATIVELY TERMINATE this case, without filing the Petition or assessing a filing fee; and it is further

**ORDERED** that if Petitioner wishes to reopen this case, he shall so notify the Court, in writing addressed to the Clerk of the Court, Martin Luther King Building & U.S. Courthouse, 50

Walnut Street, Newark, New Jersey, 07102, within 30 days of the date of entry of this Order; Petitioner's writing shall include a complete, signed affidavit that contains information to establish that Petitioner is currently unable to pay the fees and costs of the proceeding or the \$5.00 filing fee; and it is further

**ORDERED** that upon receipt of a writing from Petitioner stating that he wishes to reopen this case, and a complete, signed affidavit of indigence or the \$5.00 filing fee, the Clerk of the Court will be directed to reopen this case; and it is finally

**ORDERED** that the Clerk of the Court shall send a copy of this Order to Petitioner by regular U.S. mail.
