**PETITIONER'S NOTICE OF SUPPLEMENTAL AUTHORITY**

**NOTICE IS GIVEN** that yesterday Judge Jose Martinez in the U.S District Court for the Southern District of Florida issued a decision awarding habeas relief in a matter that is, in all material respects, the same as the present case, namely, because the habeas petitioner was awarded a bond, the decision was revoked in response to a new (and incorrect) BIA published decision<sup>1</sup>, and standard removal proceedings before the Executive Office of Immigration Review (EOIR) are still pending. *See Aguilar Merino v. Ripa, et al.* 25-cv-23845-civ-Martinez (D.E. 28). A copy of the order is attached. See Exh. "A," SDFLA Order dated October 15, 2025. Petitioner notes his intention to file a motion for leave to submit an amended proposed order in line with the recent issuance of this strong persuasive authority.
