ORDER

Petitioner, detained at Prairieland Detention Center in this district at the time of filing, filed a *pro se* 28 U.S.C. § 2241 habeas petition challenging his detention. See Dkt. No. 3. United States District Judge Sam A. Lindsay referred this habeas case to the undersigned United States magistrate judge for pretrial management under 28 U.S.C. § 636(b) and a standing order of reference.

Respondent filed a Response in Opposition to Petition for Writ of Habeas Corpus on October 14, 2025, advising the Court that Petitioner was scheduled to be removed to Armenia on October 20, 2025. See Dkt. No. 7.

Upon review of the U.S. Immigration and Customs Enforcement Online Detainee Locator System, it appears that Petitioner may have been removed as scheduled.¹ Thus, the Court finds that the Respondent should file, by **February 13, 2026**, a status report advising the Court as to the current status of Petitioner's

pending removal and whether Petitioner remains detained pending removal.
