**ORDER**

Petitioner, detained at Prairieland Detention Center in this district at the time of filing, filed a *pro se* 28 U.S.C. § 2241 habeas petition challenging his detention. *See* Dkt. No. 3. United States District Judge Ed Kinkeade referred this habeas case to the undersigned United States magistrate judge for pretrial management under 28 U.S.C. § 636(b) and a standing order of reference.

Respondent filed a Response in Opposition to Petition for Writ of Habeas Corpus on October 14, 2025, advising the Court that a request for a travel document to Cuba was pending. *See* Dkt. No. 7.

Upon review of the U.S. Immigration and Customs Enforcement Online Detainee Locator System, it appears that Petitioner may have already been removed.<sup>1</sup> Thus, the Court finds that the Respondent should file, by **February 13, 2026**, a status report advising the Court as to the current status of Petitioner's


